

# SUSTAINABLE AND CLIMATE-FRIENDLY MANAGEMENT OF THE HIGH-ANDEAN ECOSYSTEM -PROANDINO III

**Objective**

The project contributes to improving the living conditions and quality of life of small farming families in the departments of Arequipa, Moquegua and Puno.



**People served by the project**

972 families of small farmers in the Andean highlands (606 men and 366 women heads of household) in 35 farming communities and annexes.



**Results achieved**

- 12 training events were held on regenerative livestock farming, with 39% of the participants being women.
- Two events were held on ancestral knowledge.
- Women leaders from Yanque, San Antonio de Chuca, San Juan de Tarucani and Cañahuas were trained through the Sinchi Warmi program.
- Improved management tools and coordination with regional government agencies for project management by training authorities through 3 workshops in San Juan de Tarucani, Imata and Chalhuanca.
- Shearers trained by the project in mechanical shearing participated in the I National Mechanical Shearing Contest at the Macusani fair, achieving 5th and 6th place.
- Training in genetic improvement continued with events in Santa Lucía, Paratía and San Antonio de Chuca.
